Grants

Our grants team has been successful in securing more than \$30k to improve the 4-6 playground and to upgrade the swings in prep to a 4 bay swing set. This grant along with a small contribution of P & C funds will hopefully have the upgrades completed in the September school holidays. A big thanks to Jenny for her hard work and many hours taken in applying for this grant.

Munch Monitor – Cancellation of Service

Thank you to those who attended the forum last week to discuss our current online provider. Due to the ongoing fees, it has been decided that we will cease to offer Munch Monitor as an online ordering service. The final date for use will be Friday the 8th August 2014. This means that all account holders will have the first 4 weeks in term 3 to exhaust their account balance. If you still have credit on your account after 5/8/14 you can lodge a form with Munch Monitor for a reimbursement.

The P & C are working towards a solution for online ordering convenience for 2015. We are also investigating EFTPOS facilities at the tuckshop for adult and student use for a cashless option. This could also be used to place weekly orders.
