Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2016, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2016 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Employment of an **Early Years Literacy Coach** who has provided intensive coaching and mentoring for all teachers in Prep – Year 3 in the explicit teaching of reading. We have seen real growth in each student's reading achievement as well as their metacognition;
- Delivery of quality, research-based professional development to teachers and **teacher aides** in the Explicit Teaching of Reading and Tactical Teaching of Reading;
- Additional focused Teacher Aide hours to enable additional support in the **explicit teaching of reading**;
- Through the leadership and direction of the TLC (The Learning Centre), delivery of intensive intervention programs in reading through Minilit (Years 1-2) and Multilit (Years 3-10) as well as targeted literacy and numeracy support across the school';
- Delivery of intensive intervention in numeracy in years 1-3 through RoleM;

Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2016 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.
